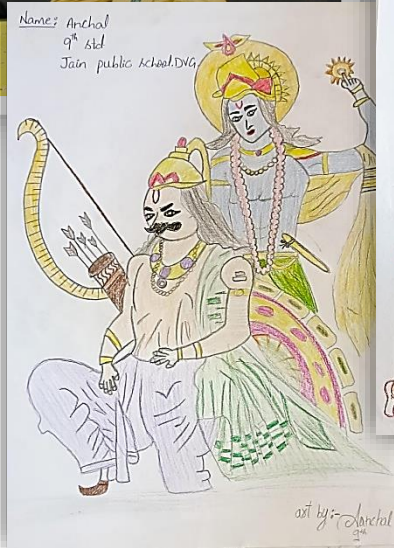

CBSE Interschool Throwball Competition

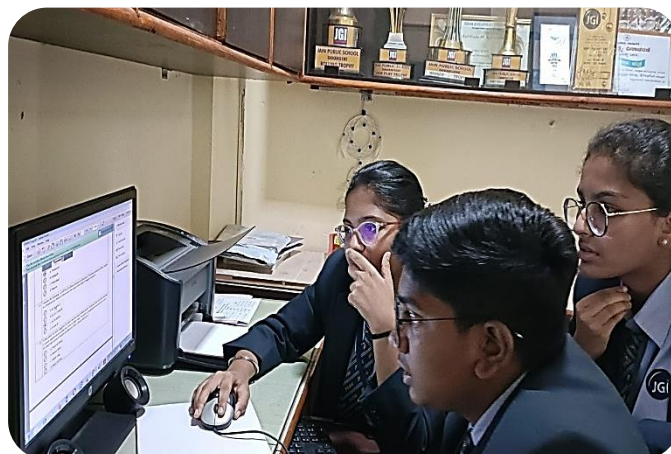

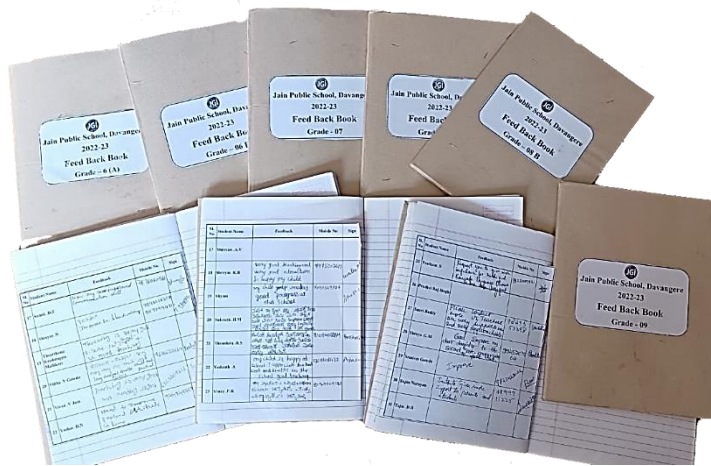


PARENTS' TEACHERS' MEETING
